¹ Based on 2011 NECAP scores for 11th grade who received a score of “Substantially Below Proficient.” Current Rhode Island regulations require a score of at least “Partially Proficient” or above in both reading and math in order to receive a diploma. A limited provision exists which allows for re-taking the tests or waivers, etc. It is unclear how many students, if any, would benefit from these provisions.

Some districts are not listed because they did not have 11th graders who took the NECAPS, or had so few that the Rhode Island Department of Education did not report the results.
