treatment for substance use disorder, but it can further positively impact their health after their

sentence is completed.

Individuals involved with the criminal justice system are much more likely to report opioid

use, and drug overdoses are one of the leading causes of death for individuals who are released

from correctional institutions. 1 This legislation would ensure that incarcerated individuals are

being provided care which is considerate of their health needs while incarcerated and afterwards,

and would aim to provide individuals with substance use disorder the tools to make the transition

from incarceration to community reintegration smoother.

The Department of Corrections has served as an enviable standard for other states in its

implementation of a MAT program. This legislation, modeled after laws enacted in New York and

Vermont, would largely formalize what the DOC is already doing, but provide statutory support

for it. This is good public health policy and good criminal justice policy. We urge favorable action

on this bill.
